ANNOUNCEMENT: - Ilkley & District Motor Club will organise a Centre Restricted Trial on Sunday 2nd January 2022 for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting. The event will count towards the West Yorkshire Championship.

ELIGIBILITY: - Restricted to registered members of clubs affiliated to Yorkshire Centre ACU. All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU Trials Registration /Membership or a SACU licence or ACU/SACU rider's licence. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident Insurance.

COVID 19: Individuals need to take responsibility for their own safety and exercise judgement as appropriate.

The event will be run under the current recommendations issued by the Government and the ACU and must be adhered to.

Anyone who has contracted coronavirus, exhibited symptoms, been in contact with someone who has been infected with the virus, or requested to selfisolate in a ten-day period prior to the event taking place shall not travel to or participate/officiate at the event and will follow Gov.uk guidance/advice as appropriate.

MACHINES: Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos; TSR 8.

START/VENUE: First rider starts at 10.45 a.m. at Dob Park Woods, Dob Park Road, Otley, LS21 2NA.

Refreshments will be available but no toilet facilities or fuel will be available at the venue.

ENTRIES: Pre-entry only via the ACU online entry www.acu.org.uk/events/Trials/. Entries will close on Thursday 30th December at 21.00hrs

Entries are limited to 125. Only those who fulfil the eligibility criteria will be allowed to enter. (No One-event Licences). You will be notified of your entry acceptance, riding number and start point by email. Instructions how to obtain your riding number

and register at the event will also be sent by email.

ENTRY FEE: All classes £20.00. Should the event be cancelled the ACU will deduct a £3 handling fee on the refund.

RESULTS: Results will be posted on the Ilkley & District Motor Club website www.ilkleymotorclub.org and in the public domain, and posted

to competitors who provide a stamped self-addressed envelope.

AWARDS: Best Performance - The A K Dawson Trophy* plus an award.

> First Expert - an award. First Intermediate - an award.

First Novice - The Sun Inn Shield* plus and award. 2nd in each class an award (subject to min. 6 entries). 3rd in each class an award (subject to min. 9 entries).

Clubman A Best Performance - J S Duxbury Reunion Shield*plus an award. Clubman A 1st, 2nd & 3rd Clubman's – awards subject to entry numbers. Clubman B 1st, 2nd & 3rd Clubman's – awards subject to entry numbers.

Youth Classes – awards subject to number of entries.

*Trophies to be held for one year only. Cash/charity donation alternatives to awards are available - see entry form

COURSE: All on private land, consisting of 2 laps of 18 sections. There will be confirmation on the day of method of closing the course. The

onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor. The route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.

METHOD of MARKING: As per TSR 22b; (no stop). Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23.

PROTESTS: As per the National Sporting Code of the ACU, section 10.04.

GENERAL: Please follow all signage and instructions. Failure to comply will result in you being asked to leave the venue.
