Founded in 1910, Ilkley & District Motor Club is one of the oldest, foremost and most active Motor Clubs in the country. Motorsport UK, the governing body for Motor Sport in Great Britain awarded us the honour of being the number one club in the country in 1995 and 1999, and recognised our centenary in 2010. The club is always ready to welcome new members, be they active motor sport competitors or not.

The club organises and has competitors in both two and four wheel sporting activities.

On two wheels, there are three motor cycle events organised each year. Their history goes back more than 90 years and are still very popular today, attracting up to 100 entries. On four wheels, competitive events are held throughout the year, both on monthly club nights and some weekends. These can be in the form of navigational challenges on public roads, economy runs, autotests and car trials. Some of the events are open to members of other clubs and invitations are received from them to compete in their events. There are Regional and National Championships in which members represent the club in a variety of motorsport activities. Ordinary road going cars can be used on most events in which the club is involved.

Visits are organised to places of interest like competition parts and sports car manufacturers or works rally teams, motor museums and even breweries.

The club meets each Wednesday for some form of activity:

The 1st Wednesday in the month is the main Committee Meeting held at the club headquarters commencing at 8.00pm. All members are welcome to attend.

On the 2nd Wednesday, an alternative venue is chosen for a 'Noggin and Natter' at a local pub. The 3rd Wednesday is usually the night when some form of competition takes place, either out in cars, or quizzes and games nights at the club house. The 4th Wednesday is the Car Competitions Committee night held at the club headquarters commencing at 8.00pm, everyone is welcome to attend. Reports on past events are given by those who were involved. Detailed plans for forthcoming events are formulated at this meeting.

There is monthly Newsletter issued to all members giving details of all forthcoming events as well as reports from members on past events, and other general news.

Applications for membership are dealt with monthly at the main Committee meeting. Members joining from October will also become members for the whole of the following calendar year. Membership renewal occurs annually on 1st January
